TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Flitch Green Extended Schools is for children of the Flitch Green Academy only.
- From September 2024, all places must be booked on the ParentMail App. The registers can be found under the 'Accounts' section. Payment will need to be made at the time of booking, unless you pay via childcare vouchers. If you wish to use childcare vouchers please contact the school office first via admin@flitchgreen.net
- Late payment will result in your child's place being withdrawn without notice.
- You will be able to book any sessions you wish at any time during the half term. However, daily registers are set to 28 places only per session. Once all places have been booked, no more will be available.
- Children **must** be dropped off and collected from each session by an adult or a young adult aged 16 or over. Children will not be released to anyone younger than this even if they are a sibling/family member.
- No refunds will be issued if your child is unable to attend a session for any reason.
- Should you be running late at the end of the day please contact the After School Club coordinator on 01371 822330.
- Children will be signed out from after school club by a member of staff, prior to being released to the adult or young adult collecting them.
- All children attending After School Club must be collected promptly at 18:00. A fee of £10 will be charged for any child that is collected more than 10 minutes late, which is payable before your child next attends after school club.
- If the late collection fee is applied more than four times in one term the Academy reserves the right to withdraw your child's place without notice.
- All children will be expected to follow the same behaviour policy set out by the Academy. Failure to follow the guidelines of expected behaviour may result in your child's place being withdrawn without notice.

BEHAVIOUR EXPECTATIONS

Academy Behaviour Management is based on the following (full details can be viewed in the Academy Behaviour Policy, which is available on the Academy website):

- Make clear to children exactly what is expected of them
- Agree a set of Extended Schools rules together
- Be consistent with these expectations
- Establish routines and organisation, which encourages self-control
- Reminding children when they break rules and imposing sanctions if this continues
- Praising and rewarding good behaviour
- Time out is given for thinking time
- Children should enter and leave the room in an orderly fashion Dismissal at the end of sessions will be carefully supervised by the adult responsible
- Persistent inappropriate behaviour may result in the child's place being withdrawn without notice

Inappropriate Behaviour

- running
- talking noisily
- throwing equipment
- damage to property
- disrespectful to staff

Logical Consequence

- go back and walk
- moved away from friends
- removal of equipment/replacement
- put it right / replace if possible
- be polite, kind and respectful
