Key updates and messages:

Secondary school admissions opened on Friday 12th September. Online applications can be made via www.essex.gov.uk/admissions.

Miss Christmas and I are also running tours for our 2026 EYFS intake and we are looking forward to our Open morning on Saturday 11th October from 10.30am to 12.

Change to term dates - Sorry for the inconvenience but the school will no longer be having a non-pupil day on Friday 13th February. If you have evidence of a holiday already booked on this day I will ensure it is authorised. We will now be breaking up for the Summer at 1.30pm on Thursday 23rd July. I will ensure the new term dates are uploaded to the school website.

Governors have also agreed the term dates for 2026-2027 for any of you looking to book holidays that far ahead. Our final day of school in July 2027 will be Friday 23rd July. Full term dates will be uploaded to the website.

In line with Essex Guidance may I please ask that children do not wear earrings when taking part in Physical Education. Essex also state that ears should not be taped. Earrings should be removed for PE lessons. Please remove earrings on PE days or ensure children are able to. Children should have ears pierced at the start of the Summer holidays please to avoid disruption to PE lessons. Thank you for your cooperation in this area.

Free school meals applications:

If you feel your child may be entitled to free school meals (even if they are already receiving them in EYFS or Key Stage 1) please pop into the office and share your National Insurance Number and Date of Birth with our office staff. We can use this to check your eligibility and if successful this also gains additional funding for the school. If vouchers continue to be issued by the local authority this would mean you were automatically entitled to these.
