<u>Y6 SATs / TAs</u> Reading - 86% at the expected standard or better (SATs) and average scaled score of 107. GPS - 86% at the expected standard or better (SATs) and average scaled score of 106. Writing - 66% at the expected standard or better (TA). Maths - 72% at the expected standard or better (SATs) and average scaled score of 104. Science - 86% at the expected standard or better (TA). Scaled scores are only for the SATs (exams). A raw score is converted to a scaled score and 100 equates to the national standard (a child working at the appropriate level for their age). For example, in maths in KS2 the three exams totalled 110 marks (raw score) and a pupil needed 56 or more to get a 100 as a scaled score.
