### Summary of objectives for 2021/22:

- To provide high quality professional development for staff to continue to improve the quality of teaching and learning in PE lessons (in-house led by a PE professional)
- To provide high quality professional development for midday staff to encourage active play at lunchtimes (in-house led by a PE professional)
- To broaden sporting opportunities and experiences to pupils, especially those currently deemed as 'not active'
- To increase participation in sports clubs after school and during holiday periods (Covid restrictions pending)
- To raise attainment in swimming to meet the requirements of the National Curriculum
